



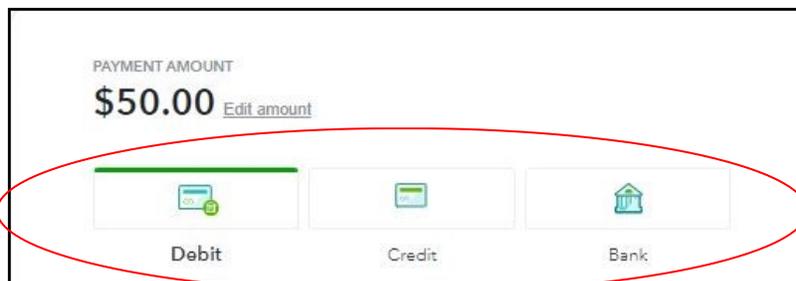
Online Invoice Payment Instructions

House Check invoices can be paid online, directly from the invoice that was emailed to you. Invoices can be paid using a Debit Card, Credit Card or a Bank Transfer. There is no fee for bank transfers. A 4% convenience fee will be charged for credit and debit card transactions.

To pay your invoice online, click on the **REVIEW AND PAY** button in the email.



The Payment Window will open and you will see 3 tabs at the top: Debit, Credit and Bank. Choose your preferred payment method.



If you would like to pay by **Debit Card or Credit Card**, enter your card information. Click on the checkbox to **SAVE** your payment information for future invoice payments. You can schedule the payment date and then click on the green **PAY** button.
